All of our Junior and Park Rangers were starting to talk about letters before the closure, and Miss Emma has a few ideas about how to extend that for you!

Junior Rangers (Toddlers):

- 1. Say the name and sound of the first letter of your child's name
- 2. Repeat the sound a few times and start finding other words that begin with the same sound "C,C,C,Carrie what else starts with "C"?

Park Rangers (Preschool):

- 1. Younger Park Rangers were working on recognizing their name see if you can help them continue to do this, and to name the letters in their own name. If they are enjoying this, start having them recognize the names of their family members too!
- 2. Older Park Rangers have been working hard on learning to write their own names. Write out their name clearly and have them copy it. Have them copy other words and names as well! "Write" (copy what you have written out) a card to a friend or a note to a parent or sibling.
