Activity 1

Make a "bucket list" with your child of goals they have for themselves. could be small like 'bake with mom' or 'go to the mooon'!

- 1. Cut out or draw a large hat shape
- 2. Discuss what a bucket list is -- goals and dreams to accomplish your whole life!!
- 3. Write down a few good ones- write as you discuss with your child so you don't miss the best ones
- 4. Draw with child to fill up the bucket
- 5. Make this an ongoing activity and track what your child dreams of accomplishing!

Activity 2

Talk about forms of travelling and how we get to the "places we go"

- 1. Draw a chart with three columns: water, air, and land.
- 2. Discuss different places around the world: could be real like Alaska, or the island of Tafiti.
- 3. Ask your child how they would get there: for example, take an airplane to France.
- 4. Fill out the columns with different modes of transportation
- 5. Talk with your child about which forms of travel they have used, and which they might want to use in the future

Math Activity

Materials:

- small objects of various colors or shapes (can be anything from pom poms, magnets, marbles, fruit or vegetables, candy or cereal pieces (added bonus: at the end of the activity, they get a little snack!)
- bowls or cups
- Work with your child to sort the objects into categories based on size, color, or another quality.
- 2. Help them if needed, and at the end count up how many are in each category (How many red pom poms?)
- 3. Discuss which bowl has the most, least, equal, etc.
- 4. Ask your kiddo questions as they complete this activity, and help them explore the various ways that an assortment of everyday objects can be sorted.
